

On entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother – Matthew 2:10-11

January 6^{th} marks the end of the 12 days of Christmas and marks the beginning of the Epiphany season where we celebrate the light of Christ – the star of Bethlehem – a sign of God's blessings. The light of the star is the revelation of

Christ to the magi, as Christmas was Christ's revelation to the shepherds. Epiphany is the day when the Magi came bearing gifts to Jesus. They were invited into the stable, to witness the life of Jesus and bless him. For us, we celebrate Epiphany to remember that we too are invited to come and see what Jesus is about and are blessed as we begin a new, calendar year.

In the days of old, during the first day of Epiphany, people would gather in one another's homes as a reminder of the magi who came to visit the baby Jesus. This became symbolic as a reminder that Christ is met in family and friends, in visitors and strangers. In the home, faith is shared, nurtured, and put into action. In the home, Christ is welcome.

One of the ways we can still bless our homes is by what is called: *Chalking the Door*. Chalk is an earthly element and was used to literally mark homes at the onset of Epiphany to remember who God is in our lives. Following the eastern European tradition, a visual blessing was inscribed with chalk above the main door. By marking our outside doors, we invite God's presence into our homes and ask God's blessing upon all those who live, work, or visit us through the coming year.

To mark your own door, write above the door frame with chalk: 20+C+M+B+23. Why C+M+B? It represents the Latin words *Christus Mansionem Benedictat* which means, *May Christ bless this house*. C+M+B can also stand for the legendary names of the Magi: Casper, Melchior, and Balthazar.

If you decide to chalk your door or even if you do not, I invite to you go to your main door and pray with your those around a blessing for all who come into visit and all who leave your home. The prayer/ blessing might include these words:

As the magi of old followed the star of God's Son who came to dwell amount us two thousand and twenty-three years ago, bless our home, our hearts with grace and our hands with humble work. May this new year be a chance to love hard, play fair, and strive for justice and peace throughout the new year. Amen.

May you know the peace and blessings of Christ throughout the new year.



Meeting called to order by President - Carrie Wiedenheft

Opening devotions were given by Jim Bertsch

Minutes of previous meeting (November 2022) were reviewed. Jim made a motion to accept the November meeting minutes. 2^{nd} by Betsy. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report for November 2022 was reviewed. Jim stated that the new Charity Fund is slowly gaining again. The Current Fund is holding its own. Millie made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. 2nd by Candy. Motion passed.

Cathy will do shut-in visitations before the end of the year.

Congregational Life – Candy Beatty – There were 49 served at the brunch on December 4. It went well and thanks to all who helped cleanup afterwards. Candy asked if there would be brunches done after the Unity Services on the fifth Sundays.

CR2009.01. A policy regarding cancellation and postponement of worship and other events is hereby established.

- a. Worship and Sunday School It is the intention of the pastor and people of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Congregation to hold worship as regularly scheduled. When weather is inclement, and when roads conditions are less then optimum, worship will be held, but worshipers should not feel compelled to venture out if they believe they may not be able to do so safely. However, in the event that:
 - 1. weather and/or road conditions are such that the pastor cannot get to the church,
 - 2. the pastor and parishioners would clearly endanger themselves by trying to do so,
 - 3. there is some other situation, such as
 - (a). a declared national, state, or local emergency,
 - (b). a serious problem with the church building, such as loss of heat or water

the president of the congregation (or vice president, should the president be unavailable) and the pastor shall confer with one another, and, upon their agreement, worship may be canceled. If Sunday worship is cancelled, Sunday School shall be deemed cancelled as well. Efforts will be made to make the cancellation known to as many parishioners as possible by phone or e-mail. Parishioners should be informed that, if they question whether worship is being held, they should call the church office. A special message will be placed on the church telephone's answering device if indeed worship has been cancelled.
