

This is the "Summer of Bread" because we hear about it for almost 6 weeks in a row. That got me thinking about tables.

Life seems to be centered around a table. Yes, I know that nowadays people might argue that our lives often center around a screen of some sort (Tv, computer, tablet, smartphone, e-reader) and I'm sure that they

have valid arguments; but to me, it seems life has always been centered around a table. We sit at a table to eat, to study, to learn, to have coffee, to share news. While our lives have an ever growing presence of screens — look around your house and count the tables. Dining room tables, kitchen tables, end tables, coffee tables, bedside tables... It is a given that there are multiple tables in our lives. There is, of course, God's table too.

God's table has taken on many forms and looks throughout the ages. God's table can be surrounded by ornate carvings or beautiful murals that make up an altar piece. God's table can be in a humble little chapel or a soaring cathedral. God's table can be found in an outdoor chapel at my favorite camp. God's table can take on as many looks as the tables we have in our homes. God's table can be lavishly set with the finest linen, silver, and candlesticks that money can buy or it can be humbly set with nothing but a plate and cup. No matter where it is or what it looks like, there is always the same feast. It is a feast of love and forgiveness. It is a feast that says you belong. It is a feast of "manna and mercy." And all are welcome.

We teach that God's table is for the baptized -- generally this is because you need to know you're in the family to come to the table. But, at the same time, guests are always welcome because they may yet find out they are family too. We teach that when we come to God's table, we find the real presence of God's love and life in the bread and cup. Some of the most important words when we come to God's table are: "FOR YOU" because while we profess that God's love, forgiveness, and mercy are for the world – at the table, in the taste of bread and cup, God's love, forgiveness, and mercy are individually offered for each and every one of us. God's love isn't just for the world... but it is for YOU!!

May the tables in your life feed and nourish you, support you in your work. May they be a place of refreshment and recreation. And may God's table, here at Trinity, be a place of nourishment, support, refreshment and re-creation. God's table here at Trinity is a welcome place for everyone, especially

Meeting called to order by Vice-President – Nancy Vollmer

Minutes taken by Pat Wiedenheft

Opening devotions were given by Betsy Stierhoff

Minutes of previous meeting (June 2024) were reviewed. Pat made a motion to accept the June meeting minutes. 2^{nd} by Jim. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report for June 2024 was reviewed. Betsy made a motion to accept the June treasurer's report. 2nd by Bill. Motion passed.

President's Report: N/A

Pastor's Report: P. Jen did a graveside service for Ruth Brandquist and making hospital visitations. She will have the wedding of Rose Stierhoff in August. P. Jen met with Father Seth of Grace Episcopal church for lunch. She is planning to meet with Pastor Mike of Zion soon. The national youth gathering is this year in New Orleans. P. Jen is hoping to get some youth from Trinity to go in 2027 when they gather again. The Women of ELCA will be gathering in 2026 (they meet every 3 years). P. Jen will look forward to attending this. The Life-Wise Academy school program was discussed. P. Jen is not in favor of this program.

Faith Builders – Pat Wiedenheft – There will be the annual blessing of the book bags in August.

Community Mission – Betsy Stierhoff – Betsy's group will be assembling 100 lunch bags for Care & Share on July 28. Bags will include Peanut Butter & Jam or Ham sandwiches, chips, fruit cup, drink, & a note from Trinity. Betsy is applying for Thrivent Funds to cover the cost of the food. An announcement for help to be put in bulletin. The group will then be meeting soon to discuss the fall schedule.

Property – Bill Bertsch – Bill will call Rex about garage door opener guy. Bill will look into the rotted parsonage basement window later. The commercial freezer in the basement is not working properly. After discussion on an estimate from Sorgen's Refrigeration Service to replace the freezer Bill made a motion to accept the bid for \$3249 for the T-19F-HC-LH freezer and the additional \$500 fee to install new and remove old. Total cost of \$3749 to be paid from the remaining flood insurance fund money. 2nd by Betsy. Motion passed. Bill will get the freezer ordered. Since the window AC units for the parsonage are working just fine Bill will not purse any quotes for whole house AC.

Stewardship & Finance – Jim Bertsch – The second half of the Community Mission Fund payout will be done at the end of July.

Witness and Welcome – Gayle Thompson – Planning visits for shut-ins next week.

Worship and Music – Nancy Vollmer/Barb Sessler – Their next meeting will be in September.

Young at Heart – Nancy Vollmer – July 28 will be the last week for donations for the Cancer Service bags. They currently have enough donations for 36 bags. Bags will be packed at the next meeting on August 14.

Old Business – Barb S & Bonnie L. are working on getting picture frames to hang P. Kathy, P. Ralph, and P. Jen's pictures in the office.



New Business – Trinity received a letter/card from St. Paul Church in Jenera OH stating that they prayed for us at their worship service.
